



## NHV Safety, Health & Environmental Policy

It is the policy of NHV to take all necessary precautions to prevent accidents and incidents, to eliminate injury or ill-health to our personnel and partners and to avoid harm to the environment while delivering our services.

This is achieved by making the management of Safety, Health and Environmental (SH&E) risks a core business function.

All of us are accountable for the delivery of this highest level of SH&E performance, starting with the Chief Executive Officer.

It is our policy to:

- **Provide** the required resources to execute our business in line with this SH&E policy;
- **Comply** with, and whenever possible, exceed legislative and regulatory requirements;
- **Define** the management of SH&E risks as a primary responsibility for all employees;
- **Manage** SH&E risks - to a level as low as reasonably practical - as part of our daily activity by means of an effective hazard identification and risk management process;
- **Define** for all employees their responsibilities for the delivery of the SH&E performance and the performance of our safety management system;
- **Expect** people to take responsibility for the potential SH&E effects of their actions;
- **Promote** an open and just safety culture, where there is a clear line of what is acceptable and what is not;
- **Ensure** no action is taken against any employee who discloses an SH&E concern unless such disclosure indicates, beyond any reasonable doubt, an illegal act, gross negligence, or a deliberate or willful disregards of regulations or procedures;
- **Establish and monitor** our SH&E performance against challenging but realistic objectives and targets;
- **Ensure** SH&E awareness for all employees by providing adequate information and training;
- **Continually** be on the outlook for improvements;
- **Ensure** that products and service provided by our subcontractors meet our SH&E standards;
- **Ensure** this SH&E policy is understood, implemented and maintained at all levels.
